

# UPS and DOWNS

A SIMPLE GAME FOR CHILDREN

## ANY NUMBER CAN PLAY

Deal the pack as equally as possible among the players.

## THE PLAYER AT THE LEFT OF THE DEALER

begins by playing a seven which he lays face up in the middle of the table. Should he not have a seven the play passes to the first player at the left who does hold one.

## THEN THE NEXT PLAYER

may play either an eight or a six, but only one card, and so on, the others building either up or down. Should a player not be able to continue the sequence but has another seven he may play that and as soon as another seven is put down that suit may be played in the same manner until finally all four suits are on the table.

## THE PLAYER

who first plays all his cards Wins the Game.
